PRIVACY POLICY FOR WWW.GETNAME.AI WEBSITE AND GETNAME.AI SERVICE

§ 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1 This Privacy Policy sets forth the principles for processing and protecting personal data of Users using the website www.getname.ai and getName.ai service (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Service").
- 1.2 The Controller of personal data within the meaning of Art. 4(7) GDPR is Robokat Spółka z o.o. with its registered office in Dzierżoniów (postal code 58-200) at Diorowska 26, entered into the National Court Register maintained by the District Court for Wrocław-Fabryczna in Wrocław, VI Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under number 0001110780, Tax ID (NIP): 8822148098, share capital: PLN 100,000.

§ 2. SCOPE OF COLLECTED AND NON-STORED DATA

- 2.1 The Controller processes the following data:
 - a) identification and contact details of persons representing the Client,
 - b) billing and payment data,
 - c) data concerning the manner of using the Service,
 - d) technical data related to API usage.
- 2.2 The Controller does not store:
 - a) content transmitted via API for the purpose of generating attributes,
 - b) API queries that are processed in real-time,
 - c) generated attributes after they are returned to the Client.

§ 3. PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

- 3.1 The Controller processes personal data for the following purposes:
 - a) performance of the Service Agreement (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR),
 - b) handling payments and settlements (Art. 6(1)(b) and (c) GDPR),
 - c) providing technical support (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR),
 - d) contact regarding Service-related matters (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR),
 - e) direct marketing of Controller's own services (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR).

§ 4. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

- 4.1 Personal data will be stored for the period of:
 - a) duration of the Service Agreement,

- b) required by law for billing data,
- c) until the expiration of claims,
- d) until an effective objection to processing is submitted.

§ 5. DATA RECIPIENTS

- 5.1 Data recipients may include:
 - a) hosting service providers,
 - b) payment service providers,
 - c) technical support service providers,
 - d) accounting and legal service providers.
- 5.2 The Controller does not share data with third parties for marketing purposes.

§ 6. SPECIFIC DATA PROCESSING PRINCIPLES

- 6.1 Responsibility for data processing:
 - a) In the standard model:
 - The Controller is responsible for data transmission security
 - The Controller guarantees GDPR compliance of the processing
 - The Controller ensures appropriate technical and organizational safeguards
 - b) In the hybrid model:
 - The Controller is responsible for data transmission security
 - The Controller guarantees GDPR compliance of the processing
 - The Controller ensures appropriate technical and organizational safeguards
- 6.2 Data security:
 - a) Technical safeguards:
 - SSL/TLS communication encryption
 - System access monitoring and logging
 - Separation of individual Clients' data
 - Automatic deletion of temporary data
 - b) Additionally in the hybrid model:
 - API key encryption
 - Processing isolation
 - API usage monitoring
 - Anomaly detection system
- 6.3 Audit and control:
 - a) The Controller regularly conducts:
 - Infrastructure security tests
 - Data protection mechanism verification

- Processing procedure control
- Security updates
- b) In the hybrid model, the Client is obligated to:
 - Regularly change API keys
 - Monitor API usage
 - Report security incidents
 - Cooperate in security audits

§ 7. USER RIGHT

- 7.1 Users have the following rights:
 - a) right of access to data,
 - b) right to rectification,
 - c) right to erasure,
 - d) right to restriction of processing,
 - e) right to object to processing,
 - f) right to data portability,
 - g) right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

§ 8. COOKIES

- 8.1 The Website uses cookies for the following purposes:
 - a) maintaining user session,
 - b) ensuring security,
 - c) collecting website usage statistics,
 - d) customizing content to user preferences.

§ 9. CHANGES TO THE PRIVACY POLICY

- 9.1 The Controller reserves the right to make changes to the Privacy Policy.
- 9.2 Users will be informed of any changes at least 14 days in advance through publication on the website.

§ 10. FINAL PROVISIONS

- 10.1 In matters not regulated by this Privacy Policy, the relevant provisions of law shall apply, in particular the GDPR.
- 10.2 This Privacy Policy constitutes an integral part of the Terms of Service.
